INFRASTRUCTURE:

The whole infrastructure of the school has been upgraded keeping in mind the needs of NEP 2020 and also upgradation to senior secondary level by CBSE. The whole of the second floor has been newly constructed for the students of Secondary Stage – i.e. consisting of classes for Std-IX, Std-X, Std- XI, Std- XII, Physics Lab, Chemistry Lab, Biology Lab, Mathematics Lab & also Activity Room for Music, Dance & Art Activities.

The first floor has been corrected for classes of only Preparing & Middle Stage from Std- III to Std- VIII. The ground floor is exclusively for Foundational Stage with classes ranging from Balvatika-I- to Std- II.

INSTALLATION OF A TRANSFORMER:

A transformer of 100 Kv has been installed in the school premises exclusively for the school to get rid of low voltage & voltage fluctuation due to overload.
